Throughout 2016 and 2017 The Little Houses Improvement Scheme, The National Trust for Scotland's Building Preservation Trust, will be restoring Bennet House, an historic building in Culross.

The renovation of this unique building is providing an opportunity to learn about a wide range of topics - from practical conservation, repair and maintenance, to buildings recording and archaeology; as well as enabling additional research to uncover the history of the building and its role in the burgh.

You are invited to join us on a fortnightly 'Hard Hat Tour' to find out about the work of NTS in conserving historic buildings, and to chart the progress of the Bennet House restoration.

Participants should meet beforehand at the Bessie Bar Hall (directly opposite Bennet House), next to the Palace, on West Green in Culross.

Please note that these visits involve visiting an historic building currently under restoration. All visitors to the house will be accompanied, on guided tours, in groups no larger than 12 people plus guide. Children under the age of 8 years will not be permitted on the hard hat tours, and anyone 16 years or under must be accompanied by an adult (at a ratio of no more than two children per responsible adult). Hard hats will be provided and sturdy footwear is recommended.
